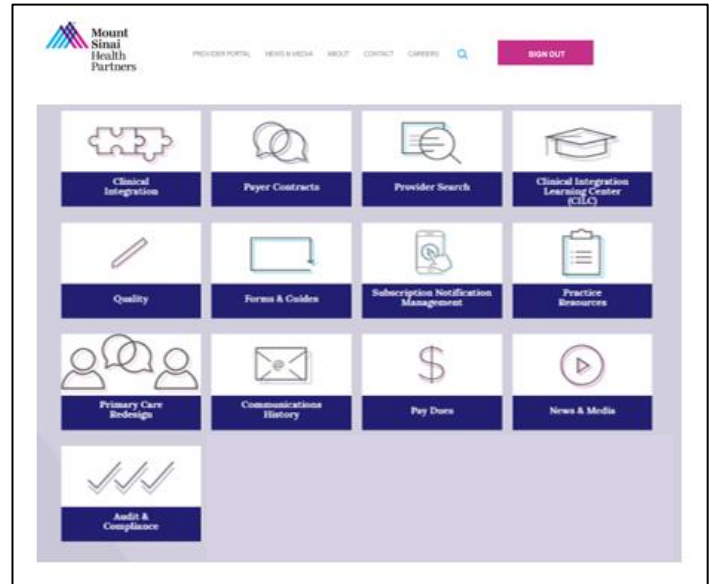


Mount Sinai Health Partners has many valuable resources available to network providers at mshp.mountsinai.org.







Sharing quality data and monitoring performance is a crucial step in improving outcomes, efficiencies, and patient satisfaction.


Quality Reporting

Mount Sinai Health Partners modified the requirements for its 2021 Quality Performance Metrics Program. Members of MSHP's clinically integrated network are not required to submit quality reporting in 2021. However, members are still expected to provide, when needed and in a timely fashion, data to support MSHP reporting of quality metrics for value-based contracts.



Physicians can click on the link below to view what payers they are participating with and the date they are active with each payer.


On this page, you will find information about MSHP rates, value-based arrangements, and other health plan-related activities for MSHP providers. You will see data based on your participation in either the Clinically Integrated Network (CIN), Value-based Arrangements or other programs.

Please note that MSHP data is sent to each health plan on a specific schedule and that will impact providers' participation date. Plan participation date is contingent on each plan's data processing and plans can take up to 60 to 90 days to process provider rosters.

When will data be refreshed? This information will be refreshed weekly on Wednesdays. Please note that due to quarterly data processing for value-based contracts, data for value-based arrangements will be updated as they become available.



3. When you see the description of the course, click on the OPEN COURSE button located on the right side of the course description.






